Hosts and Teams,

The Committee apologizes that the clarification temporarily appears to have created some additional confusion. Initially some teams and regional hosts expressed confusion over the meaning of Williams' testimony on page 25, Line 1-2, "I looked at all the other exhibits you've given me." The clarification issued earlier today was meant to clarify the exhibits to which that testimony referred. But that language does not mean that Williams, and therefore Jones, had reviewed every exhibit in the case file.

The committee did not intend to mean, however, that those exhibits were the only information reviewed by the experts. As the testimony indicates, both Williams and Jones have reviewed the sworn statements of the unavailable witnesses, which are also marked as Exhibits 19-21. Both experts reviewed the depositions of Rhodes and Kitchel, and Jones also reviewed the deposition of Williams. Furthermore, the committee agrees that Williams and Jones are familiar with the exhibits that are specifically referenced in depositions that they have reviewed.

The committee does not intend for there to be a dispute as to which information has been reviewed by Williams or Jones and hopes this additional clarification ensures a uniform understanding among the hosts preparing witnesses and schools competing.
